## What is Carpooling?

Carpooling involves two or more people using a common vehicle to share a ride together.

Motor vehicles are a major contributor to air pollution. In 2005, the National Greenhouse Gas Inventory stated the transport sector produced 14% of Australia's greenhouse gas emissions. Every litre of petrol saved reduces 2.4kg of carbon dioxide emissions from your tailpipe!! Add two people to your car and you save 4.8kg!

## How does carpooling benefit you and your community?

- Reduces greenhouse gas emissions
- Improves local air quality
- Reduces commuter stress
- Reduces traffic congestion
- Reduces costs – petrol, maintenance
- Saves time using the T3 Lane (3+ people)
- Enhances community spirit with increased social interaction between people.

## Tips for Carpooling

Before you start:

- Agree on time and pick-up location
- Settle on reimbursement costs – petrol, parking, tolls and maintenance
- Have a back-up plan in case something comes up
- Make sure you have the other person's contact details if circumstances change
- Ensure insurance, drivers licenses and vehicle registration are valid

## Carpool etiquette:

- Be considerate – music, smoking, strong perfume/cologne
- Be on time
- No detours
- Reasonably clean car
- Drive safely
